On-site Assistance Options

In addition to one-on-one coaching over the phone, the Employee Assistance Program administrator, Sand Creek, offers on-site staff development services for a fee:

- **Critical Incident Stress Debriefing:** When a traumatic event affects the workplace, members can request a Sand Creek Group counselor to visit the workplace and meet with those who experienced the event and help them cope with it.
- **Organizational Development:** Services include facilitating conflict resolution, coaching for executive and supervisory skills and training on group skills. Organizational development can help identify overall work environment issues with the goal of resolving them.
- **Workshops and Seminars:** Sand Creek can custom design employee or supervisor training and development workshops, seminars and retreats.
