Online Law Enforcement Training Proves Effective

PATROL (Peace officer Accredited Training Online) is available anywhere, anytime law enforcement professionals have Internet-connected devices. Officers can take online courses to earn credits that meet both continuing education requirements and industry mandates.

Law enforcement agencies are facing increased scrutiny from the public. In this environment, it is critical to provide deputies the training they need to carry out their duties successfully and within the letter and spirit of the law. PATROL is an effective tool law enforcement can use to provide this training.

7 Reasons to Enroll

- 1. Peace officers stay current on legal issues and mandated training:** Deputies have access to online courses covering recent case law; use of force; autism; crisis intervention and mental illness crisis; conflict management and mediation; implicit bias, community diversity and cultural differences; OSHA standards; critical knowledge; and management and leadership skills (five-part series). More than 35 courses are approved for Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board continuing education credits.
- 2. Written by experienced peace officers:** Former peace officers develop the content with input from law enforcement liability professionals, insurance defense attorneys and local law enforcement agencies.
- 3. Less overtime and travel expenses:** Deputies can complete courses within their shifts and at their own pace. They can start a program during down time while on duty, stop when they need to respond to situations and then start again when time allows. This means less overtime and travel-related expenses to cover deputy training.
- 4. Affordable:** MCIT members are eligible for the discounted one-year subscription rate of \$90 per person, which is about \$1.80 per credit. This low price makes PATROL one of the most cost-effective options for training deputies. A 30-day free trial is available.
- 5. Competency monitored:** Subscribers complete a competency quiz after completing each online course. Administration tools allow sheriffs to audit deputies' progress so they can hold people accountable for their training.
- 6. Subscriber support:** PATROL customer service representatives respond to requests for assistance within 24 hours of receiving a call or e-mail. The PATROL staff is also available to help with initial set up for new subscribers.
