The Employee Assistance Program (EAP) offers no-cost phone consultation to help you sort through concerns and find the best way to respond to employees and manage difficult workplace situations.

The supervisor consultation service is available to any department head, manager or supervisor regarding workplace issues. The conversations are confidential in accordance with state and federal laws.

On-site Assistance Options

In addition to one-on-one consultation over the phone, the Employee Assistance Program administrator, AllOne Health, offers on-site staff development services for a fee:

- **CRITICAL INCIDENT STRESS DEBRIEFING:**

When a traumatic event affects the workplace, members can request an AllOne Health counselor to visit the workplace and meet with those who experienced the event and help them cope with it.

- **ORGANIZATIONAL DEVELOPMENT:** Services include facilitating conflict resolution, coaching for executive and supervisory skills, and training on group skills. Organizational development can help identify overall work environment issues with the goal of resolving them.

- **WORKSHOPS AND SEMINARS:** AllOne Health can custom design employee or supervisor training and development workshops, seminars and retreats.
